

On Saturday, November 17th, 2018, the University will hold the English Proficiency Test (TOFEL ITP) for First-year M.A. Students.

1. Date: November 17th, 2018 (Saturday)

Time: 10:00 am to 12:30 pm

The venue will be open for entry from 9:40 am to 10:00 am, no entry will be allowed after 10:00 am.

2. Registration: Test takers should register on-line from October 22nd to October 30th, 2018.

Detailed information will be posted on the latest news of Admission Division webpage on October 19th, 2018. Test takers are advised to complete registration within allotted time.

3. Test Venue: NCU campus. Exact test venues will be announced on November 12th, 2018 at http://www.toeic.com.tw/university/university_index.jsp. To attend the test, local Taiwanese students shall present the original copy of ID card whereas overseas students will be asked to present the original copy of valid passport. No entry will be allowed for late-comers and those without the above-mentioned identification paper.

4. Test Takers:

(1) In accordance with “Prospectus 2018-19 for Master and Doctoral Admission through Screening Test” and “Prospectus 2018-19 for Master and Doctoral Admission through Exams,” new coming M.A. students (excluding students of In-Service Master Program) shall abide by department regulations and attend this proficiency test. Students may waive the test if they have already reached the graduation requirements of the department. (more information regarding graduation requirements of the department, please see:

http://www.lc.ncu.edu.tw/main/chinese/graduation_105.php). Those who are qualified for test waiver shall submit the certification to their departments.
